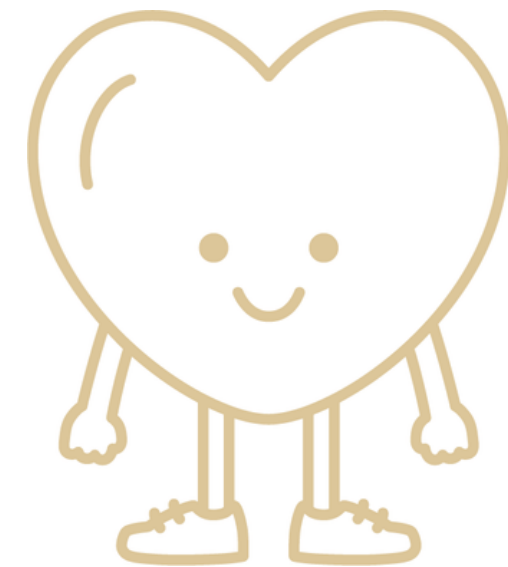

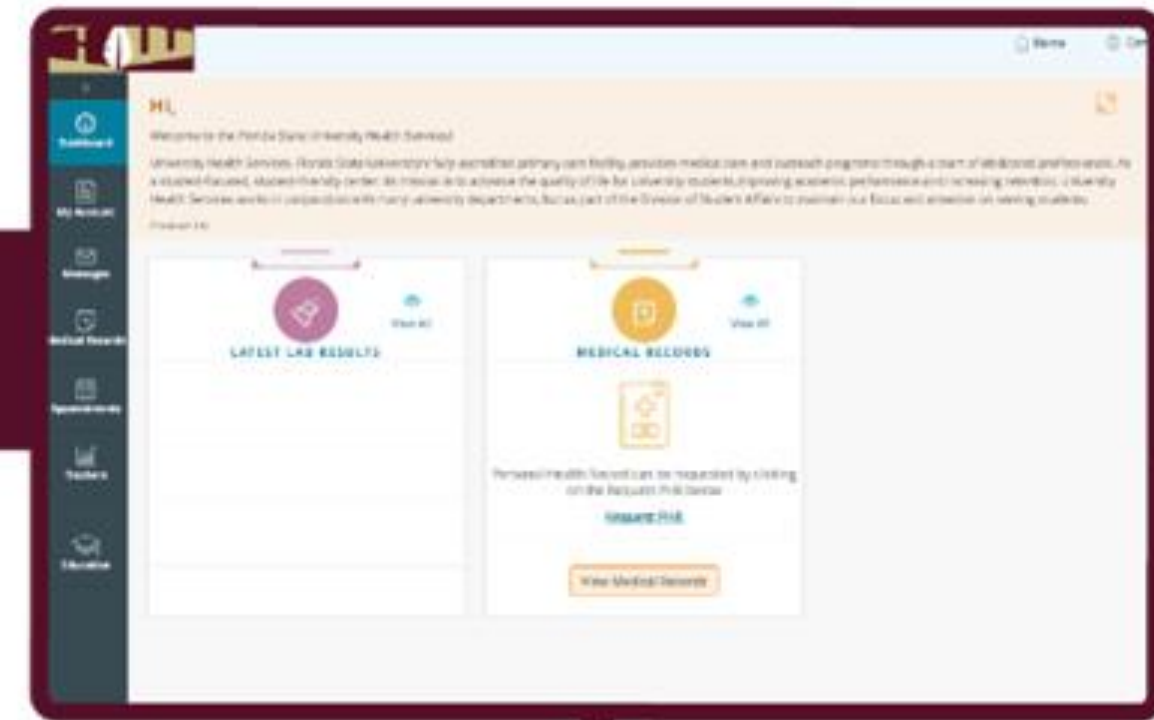

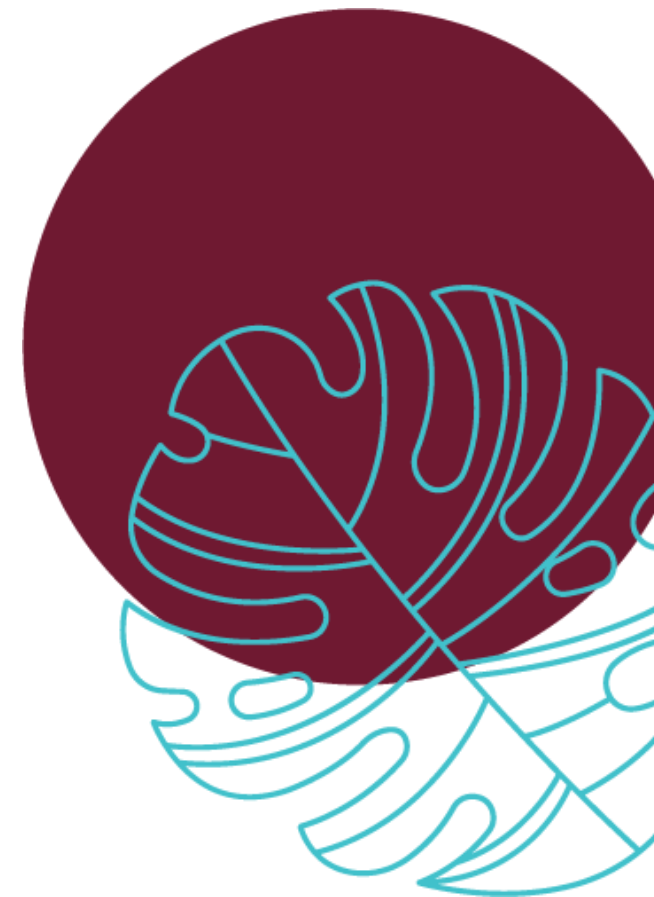

- ER care is for true emergencies and not a substitute for primary or specialty healthcare services



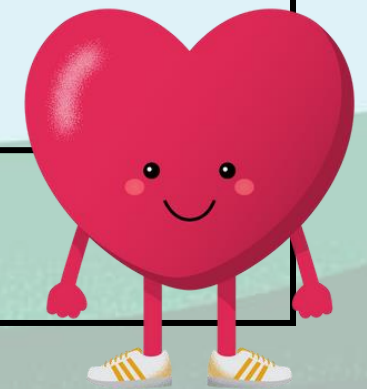
Why Choose University Health Center for Your Student's Care?

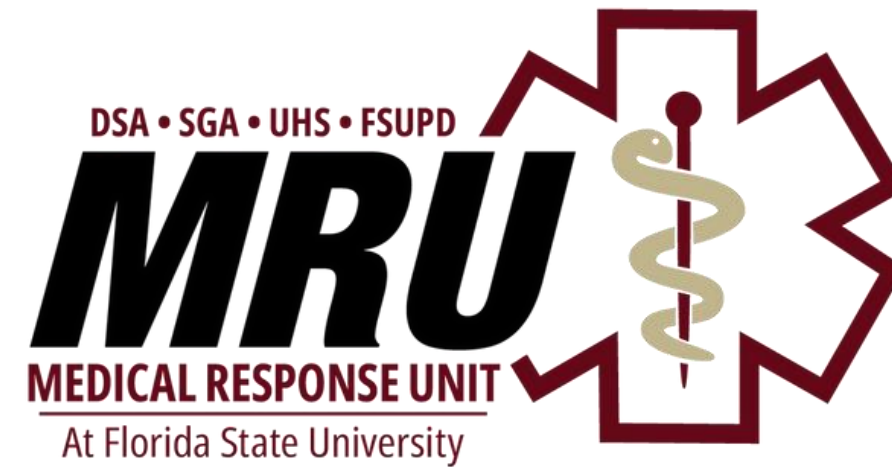

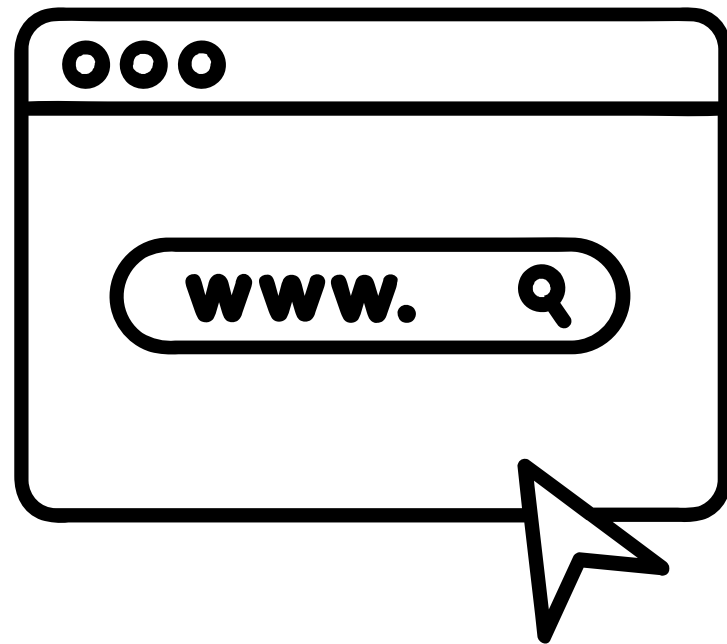

Tips for First Year Students

- Schedule an appointment by calling, walking in, or booking online.
- Bring your FSU card and health insurance card with you
- Know your medical (and family) history
 - Allergies and reactions
- Understand your insurance coverage (UHS NPI 1699809236 and Tax ID 59-1961248)
 - Know whether your insurance uses Quest or LabCorp
- Practice regular self-care
 - Bring a “feel better” kit
 - OTC medications, Band-Aids®, thermometer
 - Maintain healthy diet and adequate rest
 - Keep all appointments as scheduled
- Practice navigating the healthcare system independently prior to coming to FSU
 - Make an appointment, pay a co-pay, fill a prescription

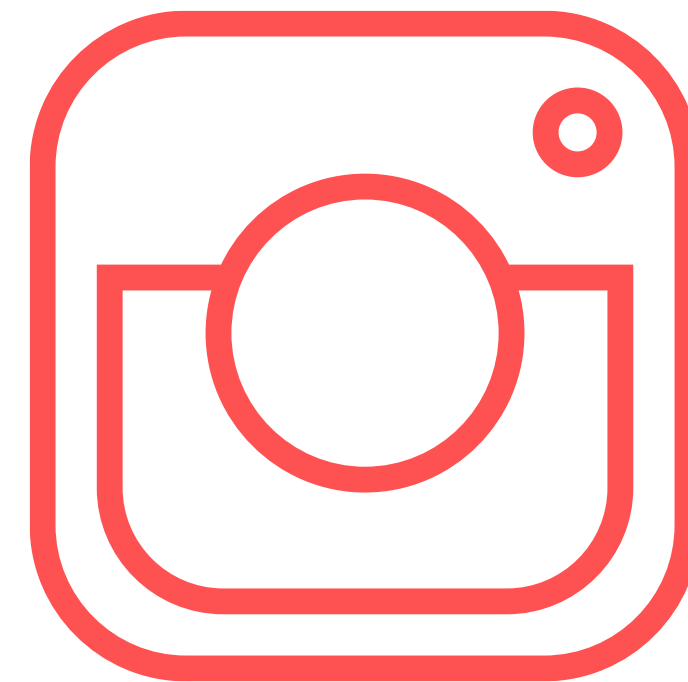

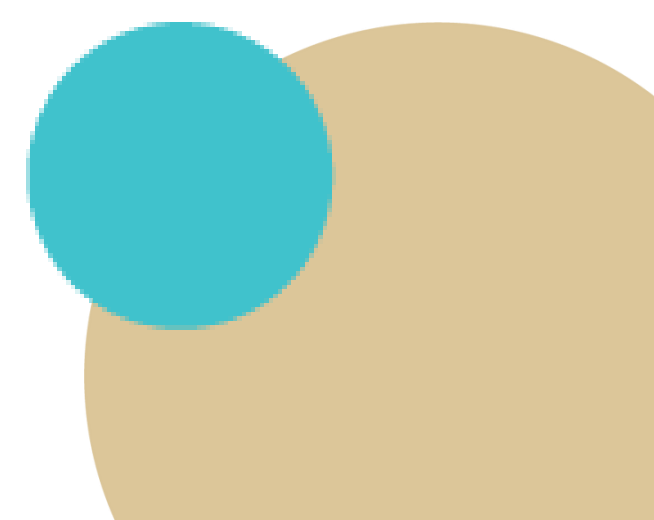
